Single-Stream

Collected weekly, curbside, in open containers. Includes tin and aluminum cans; clear and colored glass; newspaper; magazines; office paper; all types of recyclable plastics marked with recycling symbol; corrugated cardboard; flat cardboard. **No food waste. No paint cans. No gasoline or kerosene containers. No styrofoam. Any contamination will result in the container not being collected!**

Yard Waste



Collected bi-weekly, curbside in open containers from April to November. Yard waste can include grass; branches 4 inches in diameter or less cut to 4 foot lengths and bundled with twine; leaves; shrubbery cuttings. **Absolutely no dirt or rocks.** Yard waste is taken to a multi-municipal composting facility to be made into mulch. **Any contamination will result in the container not being collected!**

Christmas Trees



Collected curbside each January. Tree stands, decorations and lights must be removed. **Trees cannot be in plastic bags.** Trees are taken to a multi-municipal composting facility to be made into mulch.
